2019 South Wales Travellers Series

Organising Authority: Each club will organize their own events under their own authorities

Notice of Race

1. Rules

1.1 Rules will be defined in each event's Notice of Race Documents

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 Racing will be open to mono hull dinghies
- Boats must travel to a venue outside of their home club to be eligible to qualify for the series

3. Entries and fees

- 3.1 Entry is via the entry to any event away from the home club in the series. There is no requirement to enter this series by form or writing
- 3.2 There will be no fee for entering this series. Fees will be fixed at each event by the Organising Authority

4. Schedule

4.1 Registration

Competitors will register automatically via event results and be informed via the Tata Steel Sailing Club website if contact details are not known

- 4.2 Race schedule
 - Saundersfoot May 29th to 31st
 - Mumbles June 8th and 9th
 - Tenby June 22nd and 23rd
 - Pembroke YC June 29th and 30th
 - Llandegfedd July 20th and 21st
 - Tata Steel Regatta October 19th and 20th

5. Measurement

5.1 Each boat must have a valid measurement certificate and buoyancy endorsement, and must sail under the original sail number unless otherwise authorized by the race officer.

6. Sailing Instructions and Notices to competitors

6.1 Sailing instructions will be issued by each events host as per their Notices

7. Course and Racing Area

7.1 The racing areas and courses will be controlled by each event organiser without prejudice.

8. Scoring

- 8.1 The series will be score by taking lap times and entering into a sailwave sailing software file as much as possible.
- 8.2 Event organisers may not be able to provide the data needed to match results against individual craft. In this case, the score from the event will be taken into consideration
- 8.3 As much as practicable, the scoring will be scored using *RRS* Appendix A, except that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with her worst score excluded if 1 or more races have been completed.
- 8.4 Two scored races are required for the results to be counted.

9. Prizes

9.1 A prize will be given to the first Tata Steel SC boat

10. Risk Statement and Disclaimer of Liability

- 10.1 Each event will be responsible for the safety of competitors
- 10.2 This series does not in any way take any responsibility for the safety of the competitors taking part

11. Insurance

Boats are required to be adequately insured including insurance against third party claims at the discretion of each event hosts instructions

12. Rights to use names and likenesses

12.1 Competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority and Tata Steel Sailing Club without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.
