CORONAVIRUS – 11th UPDATE

Circuit Breaker Lockdown (“Fire-break”)

Following the First Minister’s update at lunchtime yesterday, we have received notification from RYA Wales that all boating activities will need to cease from:

6pm Friday 23rd October 2020 until Monday 9th November 2020

To quote pertinent excerpts from the recent announcement:

- This is a “stay at home order” and people are expected to stay at home as much as possible.
- All gatherings with people outside of your immediate household will not be permitted, whether indoors or outdoors, the only exception is for people living **alone** (bubble formed)
- All businesses such as retail, hospitality, leisure and tourism etc. except “essential retail” will close, like the position in April.
- No specific form of exercise is prohibited, and there are no constraints on duration/distance, however, there are practical limits on what people may do imposed by the stay at home order and the closure of some businesses. (people are asked to avoid activities that involve a significant degree of risk, e.g. swimming or other exercise at sea, or in lakes, rivers or other waterways).
- Exercise should start and end at home (unless there are mobility issues etc.).
- The period is strictly time-limited to two weeks.
