Resumption of Sailing/Windsurfing

URGENT – Further clarification from RYA Cymru on the latest guidelines advised on Tuesday, November 10th 2020

As you are most probably aware a maximum of **FOUR** people from separate households may now meet outdoors (30 at organised events). Consequently, this will impact on the club in as much as only those participating in the organised event will be allowed at the club. Sadly, it will not now be possible for people to come to the club to spectate and/or work on boats in the compound, the only exception being is that children may be accompanied by ONE adult only. However, if the quota is not reached at any organised session, then it may be possible for you to be included, and for this to happen you MUST book in with our Vice Commodore John, at john@rischmiller.com prior to turning up at the club and this must be done by midnight on the previous Friday. To avoid any upset, PLEASE do not turn up unless you have booked in. It must be stressed, that members who wish to sail/windsurf will have priority at all times and that the dinghy park should be vacated as soon as possible to allow the afternoon, then you would be more than welcome to stay.
