CORONAVIRUS – 5th UPDATE

“Return to Boating”

I have just been notified by Simon Oglesby, Works Production Manager, of the Energy HV & Utilities Department that he now has had final approval for the Sailing Club to collect boats from the reservoir for those who wish to do so. This will take place on

Friday 3rd July 2020 between 1700 and 1830 hours

and, for this purpose, the normal padlock will be restored for members to collect boats only. {4968 refers}.

It will be a direct in and out activity and only for the collection of boat(s), not to check boats, adjust covers, cut grass around boats etc. Simon will be at the club throughout to help anyone who needs help. **Strict social distancing must apply throughout, and visitors should wear gloves or use hand sanitiser when handling the gate handle and padlock.**

The Clubhouse and boatshed are strictly off limits, so no attempt should be made to access these buildings please.
