As you are probably aware, various County Boroughs are now selectively being placed back in lockdown. The latest County to affect us is Bridgend, with certain key members of the Committee not now being able to attend the Club. We have put in place contingency plans to ensure the continuity of sailing on Sundays and would ask that all members act responsibly in ensuring that they do not come to the Club if their area is locked down. **Should this occur, then you will be asked to leave the confines of the reservoir.** To avoid such actions, and any resulting upset, please act in a responsible manner to assist Stan Williams who now takes overall responsibility in my absence.

An update from the Vice Commodore:

"With the new lockdown restrictions preventing a number of members from travelling to the club, and in fairness to those competitors who cannot complete the current series, the remaining four races in the 2020 Summer Series are classified as abandoned and the series is now complete. The Ladies Race and Pursuit Race scheduled for the 11th October 2020 will be postponed. A new race series will start on Sunday the 27th September 2020, and will continue until either the lockdown restrictions are removed, or 20th December 2020. This "Lockdown Series" will be a single start General Handicap series, and will be two races back-to-back each Sunday with the first race starting at 11.00 a.m.
